Director at Minnesota State University, Mankato's
Department of Theatre and Dance.

*George got his start in theatre here in Marshall
performing at Marshall High and SMSU. He has a BA in
Theatre Arts and received his MFA in Technical Direc-
tion from Minnesota State University, Mankato. He has
had various work in Twin Cities theatres, including The
Guthrie Theater, Theatre de la Jeune Lune and Park
Square Theatre.*

Butch Roy is the Executive Director of **Huge Improv
Theater, Minneapolis**. After attending a show at the
Brave New Workshop 16 years ago, he studied improv
at the Brave New Institute and then became Technical
Director at the Workshop.

Butch earned his B.F.A. from Minneapolis college of Art
and Design. In 2002, Butch founded Improv A Go-Go, a
weekly, all improvised showcase of some of the best
local and national improvisers. Butch started the Twin
cities Improv Festival in 2006 and in 2010 he became
the director of Huge Theatre in the Twin Cities.
