

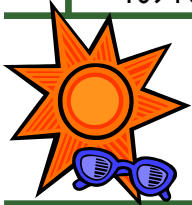

Wannabe Ina Fogarty? Raffle

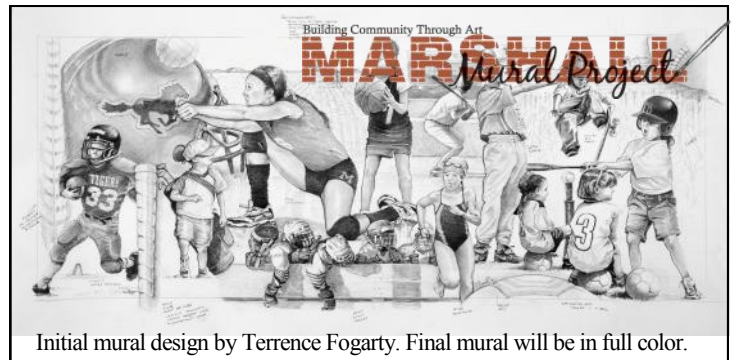
A chance to have your family member or favorite Marshall sports star included in a Terry Fogarty original.
